In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Campe of Great Canfield in the county of Essex Widdow commending my soule to God and my body to decent burial my temporall estate do thus give and besyow I give and devise unto my son John Campe and his heirs forever my freehold message or tenement with all and every the appertenances thereof Scituate lying and being in Baley End in Great Canfield aforesaid I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Campe the sum of ten pounds to be paid by my executor hereafter named within one year after my decease I give and bequeath unto my grandson John Campe the sum of five pounds to be paid by my executor att his age of one and twenty years, I give and bequeath to my son Edward Campe the sum of ten pounds to be paid by my executor within three months after my decease: all the rest of my goods and Chattells I give and bequeath to my son John Campe aforesaid, whom I appoint and ordaine sole Executor of this my last will and testament In witnesses whereof I have hereunto lett my hand and seale the thirteenth day of May in the sixth yeare of her Magesties reigne Anne Queene of Great Brittain Cs Annoge In 1707
