In the name of God Amen. The the 17th day of May 1677, I Jane Campe of ye Parish of Nasing in ye County of Esix widdow being of perfit Memory & Remembrance praise be given to the Lord for it Doe Make this my last Will & Testament in Mannor & forme folowing that is to say.

First & principally I commend my soul into ye Hands of God my Creator hoping thorow Jesus Christ my alone saviour to Receive full & free pardone of all my signes & My body to the earth to be Desently buried as to my Executors here after named shall seem Meet & for those worly goods as it has pleased the Lord to give me I dispose of as foloweth. First I give & bequeath unto the foure sones of John Halles five pounds apeece to be put forth towards Rayesing them a Stock untell thay Come to ye age of One & Twenty yeares. Further my Mind & Meaning is that if Ither of them shall Depart this Life before he cometh to ye age of One & Twenty that then in Every such case & cases his --oir part to fall Due to ye servivor or servivors of ye afore said sonns. allsoe that Each of ye said sonns shall have his Leagisie when he Cometh to ye age aforesayd though the others are then under age. And to ye wife of John halles I give Tenn shilings Allsoe I give & bequeath unto my Husbands Brother John Campes & sonn Thomas Campe Tenn shilings & to every of Thomas Campes my husbands brothers Children to Every of them I give fife shilings And to every of ye children of Mathew Day by my husbands sister I give fife shilings & to every of the Children of John Eylet by my husbands sister fife shilings further. My meaning is I give as aforesaid to as Many of them are Living at my Deces but not other wayes. Item I give to Mary Campe My kinswoman Tenn shilings & to Mary & Elizabeth Unkells one pound apeece if Demanded by them in pursone. And to some of my frends in & about Horloe I give three pounds to be Disposed by my frend Will Woodward as to him shall seeme Meet. And to certaine of my frends in Nasing fife shilings apeece that is to say Jonas Challsey & his wife the wife of William Huching ye wife of Will Woodward & the widdow Peyor to every one of them I give as afore said if living at my Decease allsoe to the poore widdows of Nasing I give Twenty shilings all which some & somes of Monyes I give to be paid Except before Executors within One yeare after my Decease. And as for all the Rest of my goods Cattells & Debts I give to John Halles & Will Woodward to pay my Debts & Leagisies & Defray My funerall Charges & that they May soe doe I make them sole Executors of this my Last will & Testament Revoking all other wills & Testaments what soe ever witness my hand & seale The Day & yeare first above written
