In the name of God Amen in the Eleventh Day of June in the twelfth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord William the Third by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender of the faith 1700. I Mary Camp of Takely in thee counte of Essex widdow being aged but of perfect mind and memory (thanks be given to almighty God for the same) Do Therefore ordaine make and declare this my testament and last will in manner and forme following that is to say first and principly with fear and reverence I comitt commend and bequeath my soul into the meritfull hands and protection of almighty God my creator hoping asurdely through the onely merits death and passion of my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ I shall receive the same with comfort att the great and generall day of judgment and my body I will to the earth whereof is a member to be decently buried at the discretion of my executrix hereafter named. Item I give and bequeath unto Mary Camp my daughter for and during the terme of her naturall life all that my copyhold mesauge or tenement wherein I now dwell at Morrill Green in the said parish of Takely together with all my copyhold arable land and pasture ground in Takely aforesaid now in the tenure or occupation of Goodman parke his asigne or assignes To Have And To Hold his said mesuage or tenement arable land and pasture grounds with all and every of the appertinences thereunto belonging to the said Mary Camp my daughter for and during the term of her naturall life, and from and after her decease I give will and desire the said mesauge or tenement arable land pasture ground and premises unto Elizabeth Beadle my daughter of Takely aforesaid for & during her terme of her naturall life and from and after her decease I give will and devise the said mesauge or tenement arable land pasture ground and premises with all and every of the appertinances unto my grand daughter Elizabeth Beadle daughter of my said Elizabeth and to the heirs of her body lawfully to be begotten for ever and for want of such leives or Issue then I give and bequeathe the said mesuage or tenement land and premises unto my grandson John Beadle son of my said daughter Elizabeth and to his heirs and assignes for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my grandson Robert Camp son of my late son Edward Camp dead one shillings within one month most after my decease Item I give and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth Beadle my daughter the bedstead and feather bed whereon I used to lie in the parlor with all the furniture there unto belonging, the biggest kittle but a quart posinott my box whwer in I lay small linen in and a long downe pilloe, and my will and meaning is that my two daughters Mary Camp and Elizabeth Beadle shall equally divide my linnon between them share and share alike all the rest of my household goods I give and bequeath unto the said Mary Camp my daughter and my mony both by me and oweing unto me I give and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth Beadle my daughter whom I make nominate constitute and appointe the sole and only executrix of this my last will and testament. In Wittnes whereof I have caused this my will to be written and read and have declared the same to be my onely last will and testament revoking all other wills formerly by me made and I have hereunto sett my hand and seale the day and year first above written
