In the name of God amen the eighteenth day of October in the year or the raign of our soveraigne Lord King James the second by the grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith & the First I Robert Campe of Thaxted in the county of Essex being not well in the body but of good remembrance thanks to Almighty God therefore do make this my present last will & testament in mannere & form following that is to say first I commend my soul in the hands of Allmighty God hoping through the merritt death & passion of my savior Jesus Christ to have full pardon & forgivnes of all my sins and to inherit everlasting life & my body I commit to the earth to be descently buried at the discretion of my executor hereafter named Item I give & bequeath unto my brother John Campe my lands commonly called Hall Gardens & also the barn by the place commonly called the Bombie lately in the occupation of John Salmon Tanner together with the house in Bishop Stratford now in the occupation of Edward Ruby & Reinhold Juby called the three tunns all which aforesaid with three acres of land in the occupation of Christopher Sharner together with their appurtenance I give & bequeath to my wife & brother John Campe all my shop goods all my bills bonds boot debts cattell corne hay grasse or what ever else not named before to be equally devided between them when my debts & funeral charges are discharged & paid Item I give to my Uncle Rochell & his wife a couple of gold rings of about 20d apiece & to my brother Shestly brother Barnerd & my mother Shestly & my brother Turner one ring apiece about the same price Item I give fourty shillings to the poor of Thaxted to be paid within one fort night after my decease my will & meaning is that my brother John Campe should enter upon what I have given him by himselfe that is the land garden & barn in the Bombie & house & land in Bishop Stratford presently after my deceas & also that my beloved wife should have the moveable goods my now dwelling house notwithstanding what has been said to the contrary but my shop goods & other things to be parted as is above said Item I do make and ordane my beloved wife & my brother John Campe executor & executrix of this my last will & testament revokeing all former wills & testaments whatsoever in witness where of I let my hand and seale the day and year above written sealed and delivered in the presence of us here
