**I Thomas Campe of Nasinge in the county of Essex yeoman doe make & ordeyne this my laste will & testament in the manner followinge In primis I bequeathe my soule into the hands of Almighty god hoping of full remission of all my sinnes through the death & passion of our blessed Saviour Christ Jhesus my body when soever it shall please God to take me out of this world I leave to be bestowed in Christian buriall at the discretion of my Executors here after named Item I give to the Minister of Nasinge ten shillings to the poore people there and the poore people of Stanndon in the Countie of Hertford where I was borne to each of them 13 s 4d to bee bestowed for bresd for them at such times as my Executrix shall thinck fitt Item I geve to my Daughter Elyzabeth my Copper or Caldron to my daughter Marie my biggest kettle & to my Daughter Joane my redd brasse kettle & to ech of them a long table cloth two paire of sheets & a dozen of napkyns such as my wiffe shall thinck fitteth for them to be delivered at their severall ages of xxi yeres or Dayes of marriage which shall first happen Item I give to my servant Thomas Wylinson as a remembrance of my affecion towards him forty shillings And to my maiden Ann Campion ten shillings All the rest of my goods Cattells chattells & moveables what soever then be I doe whollie give & bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth my Debts paid & my legacyes Discharged And my meaning is that the said somes of forty shillings & ten shillings legacyes shalle be paide within one whole yeare after my decease by my said Executrix And for my house howsinge Customary lands tenements here ditaments with all other & singular priviledge & appurtenance now in my tenure & occupacion I doe give & bequeath unto Elizabeth my loving wife uppon these condicions following First that shee paie unto Elizabeth my eldest Daughter the some of threescore thirteen pounds six shillings & eight pence of good & lawfull money of England when shee shall accomplish the age of one & twenty yeres or within forty dayes after the marreiage of the said Elizabeth which shall first happen being lawfully demanded & likewise paie unto Marie my second daughter the like some of three score thirteen pounds six shillings & eight pence of good & lawfull money of england when shee shall accomplish the age of one & twenty yeres or within forty dayes after the marreiage of the said Marie which shall first happen being lawfully demanded, & likewise paie unto Joane my daughter the like some of three score thirteen pounds six shillings & eight pence of**

good & lawfull money of england when shee shall accomplish the age of one & twenty yeres or within forty dayes after the marreiage if the said Marie which shall first happen being lawfully demanded Also if it shall fortune that either of my said children shall departe this naturall life before the said pension orsome of money shall growe due & payable that then my meaninge is that the Survivor or Survivors shall havethe said pensions or pension And for default of payment to the said Elizabeth, Marie or Joane or to eyther of them my meaninge is that my said Daughter being so payable shall enter uppon the said house & lands & sell them payeng the pensions in manner above mentioned according to my true intent & meaninge And if all my children shall this naturall life my meaninge is that my said wife shall have & enjoye all the said house & land with all the appurtenances to her & her heires for ever And I doe request Mr Edward Searle & William Benton to be overseers of this my last will & testament utterly revoking all former wills & I doe give them ten shillings a peece as a token of my love for & towards their paynes
