I give the use of my house wherein Richard FOTE dwelleth and the meadow adjoining to Sarah

my wife for her life; after her decease, to William my youngest son; if he die without heirs, to Andrew my son. To Margaret CAMPE my daughter £50. To my 4 youngest daughters Sarah, [torn], Agnes and Frances, £10 apiece at 21. To my daughter Martha SANDES 10s. To Margery PATTINSON my daughter 1 bullock and 1 black and white coverlet. To Joan NEWMAN my daughter 1 bullock. To George my son 1 mare colt. To Andrew my son my 2 mares, 1 long cart with a dung coop and my great spit, on condition that he pay my exors. £6. To the poor people of the parish of Roydon 13s.4d. The rest of my corn and cattle to my wife, whom I make ex'rix. I make my brother Robert and my son George overseers, and for their pains each 13s.4d. To Thomas SKRAGGES my servant 1 sheep and Mary SHIPPIE and Margaret BIRT each 1 lamb. Wit.
